Pinot Blow

Organically grown, gently hand-picked, naturally unfiltered – this Pinot Blanc is born on the wind-swept slopes of Steirerland. Katharina Tinnacher and Christoph Neumeister have captured a wine that speaks softly, yet blows you away.

Born on Wind-Swept Slopes

The unique geographic location of Steiermark gives rise to a cool, rain-rich climate, shaped by alpine freshness and warm southern breezes. Vineyards cling to steep hillsides, where the vines bask in intense sunlight by day and benefit from cooling winds by night — ideal conditions for cultivating wines with natural freshness and complex aromas.

Crafted with Care

Grapes are gently hand-picked and carefully handled throughout the winemaking process. Following a gentle whole-cluster pressing, the juice undergoes wild fermentation, followed by spontaneous malolactic fermentation.

The wine matures on full lees for six months, then spends an additional six months on fine lees. It is blended and bottled without fining or filtration — relying solely on natural sedimentation through gravity. A small amount of sulfur is added just before bottling, keeping total sulfur below 50 mg/L.
